WHO WE ARE

METROPLAN ORLANDO is the metropolitan planning organization for Orange, Osceola and Seminole Counties. The organization provides the forum for local elected officials, their staff, and industry experts to work together to improve transportation options for Central Florida residents, businesses, and visitors. METROPLAN ORLANDO is also responsible for long range planning and determining how federal and state transportation dollars are spent in the three-county area.

OUR BOARD

The METROPLAN ORLANDO Board is ultimately responsible for the transportation planning process in our three-county area. The following local governments and agencies are represented on the board:

In addition, the chairpersons of each advisory committee serve on the board.



COMMITTEES

It's important to consider diverse points of view during the transportation planning process. To help the METROPLAN ORLANDO Board make well-informed decisions, advisory committees review plans and provide input prior to any board actions.

Advisory committees include:

Citizens' Advisory Committee

The Citizens' Advisory Committee ensures the public has the opportunity to review and evaluate all proposed transportation plans and programs. This committee provides their opinions, concerns, and recommendations to the METROPLAN ORLANDO Board on behalf of the communities they represent.

Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Committee

The Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee promotes the inclusion of bicycle and pedestrian planning within the overall transportation system. Composed of interested citizens and representatives from local governments, this committee reviews planning, engineering, education and enforcement of bicycle and pedestrian issues.



Municipal Advisory Committee

Due to the limited number of seats on the METROPLAN ORLANDO Board, only the most populated cities in the three-county area are represented. The Municipal Advisory Committee ensures the views of elected officials from cities that do not have direct representation on the board are a part of the transportation decision-making process.

Transportation Technical Committee

The Transportation Technical Committee includes technical staff, primarily engineers and planners, from various local governments and transportation operating agencies. This committee evaluates the technical accuracy and viability of proposed plans and provides expert advice to the board.

Transportation Disadvantaged Local Coordinating Board

The Transportation Disadvantaged Local Coordinating Board focuses on the transportation needs of the disadvantaged in our community, including individuals with physical and economic challenges and senior citizens facing mobility challenges. This board specifically coordinates the needs of people unable to use traditional bus services.
